2024 New Hire Classes 1st Year Wage Rate Increase

(Hiring class)

01-02-2024:	Year 1, after 52 weeks completed \$27.145
02-12-2024:	3% on October 20 ^{th,} 2025, \$27.955
02-19-2024:	Year 2, after 104 weeks completed \$30.755
03-11-2024:	3% on October19th, 2026, \$31.685
03-18-2024:	Year 3, after 156 weeks completed (Full Rate) \$37.275
05-28-2024:	3% on October18th [,] 2027, \$38.395
06-03-2024:	
08-05-2024:	

5% last raise before the end of the CBA, October 16th, 2027, \$40.315

- The raise rate is based on the OHAP wage rate for the Labor pool classification.
- All additional wages are an addition to the base wage rate (COLA, SHIFT PREMIUM, CLASSIFICATION RATES).
- All raises will take place on Monday, immediately following your completion of the weeks worked for that year.
- Medical time after 30 days or weeks worked beyond the 30 days will delay all subsequent weeks and be adjusted by the amount of time worked after the 30 days until your return. Example: if you are off for 44 days, only the 14 days after the 30 will delay your raise by the amount that was exceeded.

Attention Gym Users: The gym will stay open but please be respectful in the future. This is a breakdown of what happened. We've received multiple reports and observed ongoing issues in the gym that need to be addressed immediately.

- Missing and damaged equipment
- Door damage to the changing room
- Equipment not being returned or put away
- Shirts not being worn (males)
- Unacceptable behavior such as urinating in cups, bottles, and in the back hallway

This behavior is completely unacceptable. The gym is a shared space intended for everyone's benefit—please treat it with respect.

Most of the missing equipment has been recovered, but a few items are still unaccounted for. Going forward, the gym <u>will be closely monitored</u>, and repeated violations may lead to <u>restricted access or other consequences</u>.

Let's work together to maintain a clean, respectful, and functional gym environment.
