UPDATES:

COLA updated: Because of the government shutdown the Union has been working on what the actual cost of living increase should be. We will be getting the official updated, but COLA will be going up **.16 cents** on top of what we are currently receiving.

December Eligible (Paid Time): Any who gets their paid time reloaded in December, please keep in mind that your 60 hours (to cover yourself, after calling off) is per calendar year. If you have already used your 60 hours for 2025, you will not be eligible to cover yourself until **January 1, 2026**.

D2D Transfer (Department to Department): Labor pool employees looking to transfer to another department may sign up using the Ohio Assembly Web page starting **December 1, 2025**.
