UPDATES

• **Vacation Shutdown** – Ford Motor Company has notified the International UAW and Local UAW that several VO plants will not have a Vacation Shutdown in 2026. OHAP is one of those plants. Which means your reserved (40) vacation hours saved for Vacation Shutdown will be released.

- December eligible vacation hours have been released
- June eligible vacation hours will be released after June 1

Please follow the normal days off scheduling process to use this time. Demand and Recovering production losses are the reasoning behind not having a shutdown.

• **Department to Department (DTD)** – The sign-up period will be the first full week in **April**.

• **Election / Voting** – The General Election begins on **May 5, 2026 at 12:00 PM (noon)** and ends **May 6, 2026 at 12:00 PM (noon)**. Voting will take place at **UAW Local 2000 Union Hall**.

Many people have been asking about the upcoming election. At the last Union meeting, the membership voted on both the dates and the location. While voting has traditionally been held at the Plant, the membership chose to hold this election at the hall.
