UPCOMING OHAP H LINE LAYOFF (Weeks 3/30/26 & 4/6/26)

Due to the upcoming Good Friday and Easter Monday holidays, there will be no mass layoff number for the next two H Line layoff weeks. **Most members on the upcoming layoff split will have worked this week, which entitles them to holiday and short work week pay for both of the next two weeks. Those on continuous layoff will continue to file with their current number.**

Please note: Members MUST have worked this week to qualify for the holiday and short work week pay. If anyone on this split didn't work this week (medical, discipline, just added to TLO, etc.), they must contact Labor Relations for instructions specific to their situation.

GENERAL ELECTION: Our membership approved the dates of our upcoming elections at the last meeting. The General Election begins on May 5, 2026 at 12:00 PM (noon) and ends May 6, 2026 at 12:00 PM (noon) at **UAW Local 2000 Union Hall.**
