A Workers’ Memorial Day message has been developed to support this important commemoration that will air on the plant communication network.

Update from the Chairman regarding Grievances: I wanted to update everyone about the grievances that I have in the 2 ½ stage (comes to Chairman for resolution). I currently have 29 grievances open out of 169 from when I took office. The last three grievances that I picked up are policy grievances that affect everyone.

CC31626CB – Grievance for work rules. **JW2025** – Grievance for random lunch box searches. These grievances were both denied by the company because these policies have been in place for many years and are in place at all Ford locations. Ford and UAW have had a long-standing agreement to these policies/work rules. Since Ford and UAW agreed to these, they will now get sent to the 3rd stage (passes from Chairman to UAW International) for resolution.

As a note we will be unable to settle any long-standing policies / work rules that affect all Ford locations, so any of this nature will be passed to the 3rd stage.

HB25JW – Grievance relates to the delay on the 2023 CBA commitment (new vehicle) for Ohio Assembly Plant, this grievance was filed 9/8/2025. This grievance was denied by the company because no contractual violation has occurred at this time as the contract runs through 2028. I will hold on to this grievance, because if we don't see movement of our product by 2027, we will pursue resolution.

Election / Voting: The General Election begins on **May 5, 2026 at 12:00 PM (noon) and ends May 6, 2026 at 12:00 PM (noon)**. Voting will take place at **UAW Local 2000 Union Hall**.
