OHAP H LINE LAYOFF (TWO WEEKS – 8/3/26 AND 8/10/26)

Due to the fact that so many have returned to work from the TLO, there aren't enough people to get a mass layoff number from ODJFS. Please follow the instructions below to claim your weeks without a mass layoff number:

Reopen your application. Your effective date is **08/02/2026**. Your last day worked is **07/31/2026** and your return to work date is **08/17/2026**. See below for dates you need to file:

- 1. Monday, 08/03/2026 – Call your processing center or use the live chat option to reopen.**
- 2. Sunday, 08/09/2026 – Claim layoff week ending 08/08/2026.**
- 3. Sunday, 08/16/2026 – Claim layoff week ending 08/15/2026.**

Please note: If you run out of unemployment money for the year and you can't file weekly claims: **EACH WEEK** you will need to print or screenshot the front page of the unemployment screen when you first log in that shows you can't file any more weeks, then take it to HR or screenshot it and email it to HR at **askohap@ford.com** in order to get your SUB pay. Be sure your name and the date are in the snapshot or printout.

EXPIRED CLAIMS: Also, it's important to pay attention to the top corner right corner under claim summary/payment summary page for when your claim is expiring. **If your claim expires and you choose to file another week instead of opening up a new application at the very top, it will create an issue and you won't be paid on time.** They're not backdating claims, either, so **please make sure your claim isn't expired before you file your week.**
