Labor Day will be recognized as a paid day off... Monday September 7, 2026.

TFT'S need to have 90 continuous days to be eligible for holiday pay.

COLA UPDATE FOR SEPTEMBER

The UAW announced a COLA increase **effective September 7, 2026**, for Ford workers. The current COLA of \$1.73 per hour will increase by \$0.42, **bringing the new total to \$2.15 per hour**. The COLA formula initially produced a \$0.52 adjustment, but \$0.10 was diverted under the agreement. The increase is based on the CPI-W three-month average rising from 312.229 to 316.879.

TFTs must be converted to full time and achieve 90 days seniority to be eligible for COLA.
