Haven't Received Your IUAW Ballot Yet?

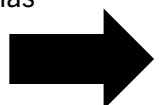
If you believe you are eligible to vote in the **2026 UAW International Executive Board Election** but have not received your ballot, you can request one by visiting:

The deadline to request a ballot is September 23, 2026. (Tomorrow) According to the election notice, **the deadline for ballots to be returned is October 5, 2026.** Don't wait last minute to request or submit your ballot.
